FREE H1N1 VACCINATIONS

The Paramus Board of Health is offering free H1N1 vaccinations to all residents of New Jersey 4 years of age and older. To be eligible to receive the vaccine, you must not have an allergy to eggs, egg products or to a component of the vaccine; have never had a reaction to a previous dose of flu vaccine; never had Guillain-Barre Syndrome (a temporary severe muscle weakness) within 6 weeks after receiving flu vaccine. Pregnant women are required to bring a medical clearance note from their doctor.

The program will be held in the caucus room, lower level of Borough Hall, on Monday, March 22, 2010 from 5:00 – 8:00 pm. Participants are asked to remain for 15 minutes after receiving the vaccine for observation.

Although walk-ins are welcome, it is requested that those interested should register by calling the public health nurses at 201-265-2100, Ext. 615 or 618.
