

**PARAMUS GOLF

**6. Finance**

The course was closed for play for the month of February due to snow coverage. The new rates were approved for greens fees and PGC began taking memberships on February 25<sup>th</sup>. Comparing this February's revenue to the last 5 years showed a 82% decrease which is due to the weather and not taking registrations until rates were resolved. Andy anticipates making up a bulk of the membership registrations in March.

**7. General Manager/ Superintendent Report:**

Staffing: 5 full time positions are opened and are advertised in the Record. 2 full time staff were transferred to the Recreation Department for the Field Division.

**8. Old Business:**

No report on the status of the restaurant. Golf has upgraded their systems to window 10 and now are moving to a cloud base server for the online reservation system. While the course waits for the online reservation to go live, they will use the old system with the new tee time access in place.

All shot gun outings received an email informing them that their outings would not take place this year.

**10. Meeting open to the public: 5 minutes maximum per person**

John Carpentiri, Paramus resident and PGC member, inquired if the online reservation system is able to be used on a smartphone. He also questioned when the golf course moves to the online reservation system if it will be a combination of online, phone and in person to obtain a tee time. Andy replied that the reservation system is able to be used on the computer and smart phone devices. The primary way to obtain a tee time will be online only but the staff will assist those who need help booking.
