BOROUGH CLERK’S REPORT:

- a. Millennium Strategies –March 2021 Monthly Report
- b. Request received from the All American Corvette Club to hold their 21st annual car show in the parking lot of Panera at 165 Route 45 West at 10:00 AM. **Approved.**
- c. Request received from the Paramus Elks to hold music events in their parking lot on Sunday, April 25th, May 23rd, July 25th and August 29th from 11AM- 6PM. **Approved.**
- d. Request received from Paramus Elks to hold car shows in their parking lot on Sunday June 27th and October 10th from 9AM- 3PM. **Approved.**

Paramus Chief of Police Kenneth Ehrenberg, Deputy Chief Robert Guidetti and Captain Lagrone are present to discuss medical/recreational marijuana. Mayor LaBarbiera gives background including an ordinance previously introduced by the Council precluding recreational marijuana. Mayor LaBarbiera asks the Chief to weigh in as a professional in the police field regarding how this would affect the department’s ability to police/enforce. Chief Ehrenberg and Mayor LaBarbiera discuss the zones of the Borough where this is being considered. Borough Attorney Daniel Lagana advises that an ordinance is being drafted but right now it only addresses medicinal. It will basically lay the framework of what will be permitted as far as adult use – which includes how the Police Department will play into it. The protection of residential neighborhoods is paramount. Chief Ehrenberg advises that the department has done numerous tours of the medical dispensary in Paramus and points out that they have a close working relationship with the manager. He

describes the atmosphere of the dispensary as being sterile. He believes it's very well regulated. There are less medical marijuana cards out there than you would think. Chief Ehrenberg points out that most of the department has not even come in contact with anyone who has one at this point. Chief Ehrenberg doesn't believe this will have any effect on the black market and it won't fix that. He doesn't see it causing an issue for Paramus and believes the customers will be legitimate. People who buy it on the street will likely continue to buy on the street. The product will be cleaner from the dispensaries whether it's medicinal or recreational. Everything is done on camera and is regulated by the state. The security is incredible. It will be regulated in areas where there are "no smoking" signs. No smoking means no smoking. Mayor LaBarbiera points out the amount of control the Council would have. We really just don't want it abutting residential areas at this point. Councilman DiPiazza inquires about the "cash only" aspect and how it would relate to crime as far as robberies. Chief Ehrenberg advises that the money goes right to the bank who comes and picks it up. Only a certain amount of cash is kept on the facility. He doesn't see this as being a problem. Deputy Chief Guidetti advised that when they toured the facility they noticed safety precautions such as vaults and safes. Councilwoman Bellinger expresses her concern regarding underage users. Her concern is not at all with the facilities. Chief Ehrenberg agrees with her concerns but believes the state needs to have a firmer stance on the underage issue. Councilwoman Weber agrees with Councilwoman Bellinger's concerns. She has seen other towns passing resolutions banning the use of recreational marijuana in their municipalities. Councilwoman Weber states that she is totally against it and will stand her ground. Councilman DiPiazza points out that we have to keep in mind and remember what's best for Paramus itself. Mr. DiPiazza references a receipt that he saw when he was in Colorado that showed the tax benefit of selling marijuana. Chief Ehrenberg points out that this is a regional issue. Even banning it in Paramus would not prevent users from traveling through town and being on the roads anyway. Councilman DiPiazza asks Chief Ehrenberg if marijuana will bring more crime to Paramus and change the "element". He points out that there is a stigma with marijuana that associates with low income. Chief Ehrenberg advises that Paramus isn't going to be the only place with recreational marijuana. Chief Ehrenberg states that the Police Department is not in opposition. Captain Lagrone's opinion is to treat it like alcohol. Mr. Lagana describes parts of the application process. Councilwoman Tedesco-Santos reports that Rise will be donated a portion of their first week of sales to the Children's Health Foundation.

Mayor LaBarbiera opens to the public for comment on the topic.

Jean Hegg – Ms. Hegg has mixed emotions about the marijuana topic. She has heard people express a concern about the "type of people" marijuana will bring to the borough. Ms. Hegg is a medical marijuana user and she is proud of it. She runs a business from her home and has healthy successful children. A dispensary will not change that. Ms. Hegg urges the Council to stop by the dispensary and tour it.

Joe Cafone – believes medical marijuana is necessary for those who are sick and need it. Inquires about why medical marijuana is not sold in pharmacies. Mr. Cafone advises about the zones where it is allowed. Mayor LaBarbiera responds.

Jean Hegg – asks about a comment made prior in the meeting regarding someone smoking marijuana in the parking lot at the gym.

Councilman DiPiazza asks Mr. D'Arco about the tree trimming trucks at the pool parking lot. Residents have been complaining. Is there a plan in place? Mr. D'Arco advises that its PSE&G doing work in town and that was one of the safest places geographically to keep their trucks. They are supposed to be out by the middle of this month.

Councilwoman Weber the DPW road department used 1,500 tons of salt this past winter. Buildings & Grounds are working on improvements at the Police Station and Borough Hall. The electric charging stations have been installed in the borough hall parking lot.

Ms. Weber would like resolution 21-04-245 removed from the consent agenda. Mr. Lagana informs the Council why this resolution is being sent to the Planning Board. Ms. Weber asks if the stockholders of this property were notified. Mr. Lagana advises that notice will be required when the Planning Board does a public meeting. No notification is required at this time. The Council has several question and the resolution is pulled from the agenda altogether.

Councilwoman Tedesco-Santos The Pool has started registration for membership. Recreation started Lacrosse and is getting ready to do interviews for the summer playground. Registration for football & cheerleading is opening some time in May. The Board of Education's tentative budget for this school year is \$100,000,000.

Councilman Verile- No Report

MAYOR'S REPORT: A property adjacent from Life Safety has become available. Mr. Picone thinks it would be of significant benefit to the borough as far as parking. The appraisal that came in was for \$500,000. The few spaces available could be utilized without the property. With the budget issues we have, we would not reap the benefits from spending that money on a few parking spaces.
