1. Notice of meeting:

This is a regular scheduled meeting of the Golf Commission and the notice requirements provided for the "Open Public Meetings Act" have been satisfied. Notice of this meeting was properly given in a notice which was transmitted to the Record, filed with the Clerk of the Borough of Paramus, posted in Borough Hall and posted on the Borough Website.

5. Finance:

Rounds were up in April. There was a \$16,000 increase in the lottery this year and morning leagues are up 6.5%. The month of April was above average, partly due to PGC closure during covid last year. Another reason the month of April was up was because the lottery was included in April which typically takes place in March.

Ytd compared to the last 5 years the course is up 25.5%.

6. General Manager/ Superintendent Report:

Staffing: Open positions for maintenance.

Course conditions: The course is filling in nicely from aerations.

Mini golfs opening date is tentatively Memorial Day Weekend. Mini golf required a lot of repairs before opening this season. The features at mini are being updated, the ponds have been drained. Suez came to turn the water on and now the ponds can be filled.

PGC is in the process of locating a vendor who has lava and river rock.

7. Old Business:

Restaurant – The Iron Horse will be the new restaurant at PGC.

Electric is almost completed in the club house. Andy would like to thank those from building and grounds for all their efforts to get us up and running.

Golf carts- Some carts have required battery replacements and is in the final year of the lease.

Ralph commented he is elated with the new vendor.

8. New Business:

Tournaments: PGC will be running tournaments. The tournament committee met last night. A chairman has been named for the committee. Andy commented it is a great group of volunteers that are helping out this year

John Carpentieri, resident, commented that the course is in good shape except for some garbage on the course. He also inquired on the online tee time system and touch points (rakes, ball washers, etc).

Nancy Vasile, resident, stated on behalf of the PGA membership she thanked the golf commission for the reinstatement of the club tournaments and appreciated their support. She also questioned the purpose on some of the fescue that is now growing in.

James Cullen, resident, inquired if the Iron Horse was approved by the town council and if Andy knew if the contract was executed. He also asked how the process of reinstating touch points on the golf course works.
