- A. Playground Update

 - b. She informed the commission that in addition to EMTs, there will be at least two other CPR Certified staff on site.

- C. Director Schaffer reported that the expense of promotional brochures is over \$11,000 yearly. She stated that she would be looking into online promotional sources to save money and paper.

- E. She informed the commission that the location of track has been moved, due to some unexpected construction taking place at BCC. She stated that she has reached out to PHS about utilizing the track after the lacrosse season ends.

- A. Assistant Director Garino presented to the commission that discussion over winter basketball tryouts, and having the coach's involved in the selection process has been brought up by multiple volunteer coaches.
