MUNICIPAL BUDGET 2022

CY 2022 BUDGET PUBLIC HEARING – 6:35 PM – No Public Comment

Paul Lerch, Auditor, present to discuss & answer questions about the 2022 Municipal Budget. Mr. Lerch discusses the lack of surplus, and the revenue brought in by permitting, court fees, shared service agreements, etc.

This budget document includes the American Rescue Plan which is coming in as a revenue. It's offset with Police salaries and administration. Delinquent tax anticipated number is down because the collection rate is up. General taxation makes up the bulk of the revenues. The 2022 budget is at the maximum tax levy cap. The major components of spending are discussed. Major increases in utilities are due to things like fuel costs. The library contribution is a

statutory requirement. Pension & Social Security are both up. The appropriation cap goes back to the 1970's and it limits the amount that can be raised. The tax rate is going down but the assessed rates are going up. The presentation concludes with the effect on the average residential home. The predicament the Borough is in is caused by the limit on the amount that taxes can be raised. In 2018 through 2021 there were emergencies that needed to be accounted for and the Borough was at a deficit. The rating agencies lower the ratings when they see the loss of surplus over an amount of years.

Mayor LaBarbiera points out that the previous auditor recommended raising taxes, and the Council collectively wanted a zero raise, and in turn the borough blew through the surplus. Previous council members who were up for re-election were interested in keeping taxes at a zero raise.

The budget is being reviewed and an amendment is required which will be advertised before adoption.

Once the DLGS approves the documents that have been sent to them for review, the budget can be adopted at the next Mayor & Council meeting, or a special meeting can be held for adoption.

hired experienced a truck issue and it was being serviced for a month and a half. When he gets his truck back Cornell Road will be serviced.

Councilman DiPiazza asks Mr. Giblin to explain to Ms. Parisi & the newer members of the Council why the Shade Tree Commission is on their own and not under the governance of the Governing Body. Mr. Giblin responds that it's state law. Mayor LaBarbiera reminds the Council that they discussed the idea of dissolving the Commission and making it a committee, which would not be covered by the same laws. The Council would have more control.

MATTERS FOR DISCUSSION: Mayor LaBarbiera reminds the Council of the discussion in years past regarding implementing bike lanes on Midland Avenue. There was pushback from the residents and the plan was stopped. In the last couple of years, there were improvements done to Midland Ave, and the stripes were put in for bike lanes. There is no signage yet. The Council has to decide if it wants to continue with the bike lane markings, or pay money to have the stripes removed.

John (inaudible) – lives on Midland Ave and is concerned about the parking. Bike lanes will prohibit any parking in front of houses on Midland Ave, regardless if they are supposed to park there or not. Mayor LaBarbiera will advise them to hold off on the lane markings to see if there is any room to figure something out.

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT: JIF safety inspected all the buildings and the Borough did very well. The Department Heads met with a company who archives social media. This would benefit the Borough for OPRA purposes if a request comes in for a social media thread that has been deleted by a member of the public. This would be \$5,000 per year. Health insurance rates are going up 24%. Our insurance is up and Mr. Olmo is shopping our JIF insurance and health insurance. DPW superintendent had a question regarding the Soldier Hill agreement if it included a pump station. Mr. Olmo will look into it to see if there is work they have to do before the Engineer gives estimates of what the work will cost. The DPW Superintendent believes it would be beneficial financially to separate Mechanical from underneath him and create a separate

supervisor for Mechanical. The Borough would save in the overtime that the mechanical employees are making. When the employee becomes a supervisor, they will no longer be able to receive overtime. Mr. Olmo points out that Hassan Brown is doing a great job and is very good for the department.

Councilman Quintana – the overgrown grass at the overpasses on Route 17 South looks like a garbage disposal. Mayor LaBarbiera advises that the DOT is responsible for that area.

Councilwoman Weber – a CPR training class was conducted with Councilman Antonio & the Health Department would like to thank him. The DPW is working with Maywood & Bergen County to help with flooding on Swan Court. A meeting was held and it all drains to Maywood.

Mayor LaBarbiera will add an ordinance next meeting regarding recreational marijuana and the Council can do with it as they wish. Looking at what's going on with the budget, the Borough could benefit with the revenue.
