ORDINANCE No. 19-18

ORDINANCE AMENDING PARAMUS CODE § 419-18

Section 1. Purpose & Authority. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-2, 40:49-2, and 39:4-8(c), the Paramus Governing Body hereby amends Section 419-18 of the Paramus Code to prohibit parking on Paramus property without specific or implied permission.

Section 2. Prohibited Parking Amendments. Section 419-18 of the Paramus Code is hereby amended as follows. Additions are highlighted.

- A. No person shall park or permit the parking of any vehicle except in a space designated for parking.
- B. No person shall park or permit the parking of any vehicle except when the vehicle is entirely within the lines establishing a single parking space.
- C. No person shall park or permit the parking of any vehicle on the lands or premises of the Borough of Paramus, without specific or implied permission. Implied permission as used in this section means parking on the lands or premises of the Borough of Paramus to use or visit the Borough's facilities or premises for a purpose directly related to an event, service, or other amenity being offered by the Borough to the public.
- D. Any unoccupied vehicle parked or standing in violation of "Section C" may be removed at the owner's expense. Towing and Storage fees are set forth in Chapter 401 "Towers and Wreckers".
- E. The minimum fine for illegal parking under this section shall be **\$250**. Each date a vehicle is illegally parked under this section shall constitute a separate and distinct offense punishable by separate fines.

Section 3. Repealer. All prior ordinances that are inconsistent with this ordinance are repealed. All ordinances are hereby amended to be consistent with this ordinance and all ordinances, including this one, shall be construed consistent with the express purpose of this ordinance.

Section 4. Savings and Construction. This ordinance shall be construed consistent with the purpose stated in section 1 hereof. Any ambiguities in this ordinance shall be construed in accordance with the purpose of this ordinance. If any part of this ordinance is invalidated by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance shall be saved to the full extent possible. This ordinance repeals provisions of the Paramus Code only where stated herein; otherwise this ordinance is amendatory and supplementary to existing provision of the Paramus Code.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and publication of notice of adoption as provided by law.
