**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 436A-3 OF THE PARAMUS CODE
WITH RESPECT TO BARBERSHOPS, BEAUTY PARLORS AND NAIL
SALONS**

Section 1. Purpose and Authority. The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Chapter 436A of the Paramus Code, entitled “Barbershops, Beauty Parlors and Nail Salons”

Section 2. Amendments. Chapter 436A of the Paramus Code is hereby amended to add the following highlighted provisions:

§ 436A-3. Annual inspections.

A. The Health Officer shall promulgate such rules and procedures as are necessary to ensure compliance with this section.

B. At least once a year, the Health Officer or his/her designee shall inspect each barbershop, hairdressing and/or cosmetology shop/salon and nail salon/shop and shall make as many additional inspections as are necessary for the enforcement of this chapter.

C. The Health Officer or his/her designee, after proper identification, shall be permitted to enter, during normal operating hours, any portion of any barbershop or hairdressing and/or cosmetology shop/salon or nail salon/shop for the purpose of making inspections to determine compliance with this chapter.

D. In the event that the Health Officer or his/her designee finds unsanitary conditions in the operation of a barbershop or hairdressing and/or cosmetology shop/salon or nail salon/shop, or if a violation or multiple violations occur, the Health Officer or his/her designee may immediately issue a written notice to the license holder, or person in charge, citing such conditions, specifying the corrective action to be taken and time frame within which such action shall be taken. If corrective action is not made in the allotted time, a court summons may be issued.

E. Registration of Barbershops, Beauty Salons and Nail Salons. Any business for which a license is required under N.J.S.A 45:5B-7 (including hairstyling, beauty culture, barbering, manicuring, skin care specialty services) must pay a yearly

registration fee to the Board of Health in the amount of \$150.00 for the cost of yearly inspections and investigation of complaints. The yearly registration fee shall be due and payable on or before the first day of February in the year of renewal, unless the Board of Health provides an extension in writing to the owner or operator of the business.

Section 3. Repealer. All prior ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are repealed. All ordinances are hereby amended to be consistent with this ordinance and all ordinances, including this one, shall be construed consistent with the express purpose of this ordinance.

Section 4. Savings and Construction. This ordinance shall be construed consistent with the purpose stated in Section 1 hereof. Any ambiguities in this ordinance shall be construed in accordance with the purpose of this ordinance. If any part of this ordinance is invalidated by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance shall be saved to the full extent possible. This ordinance repeals provisions of the Paramus Code only where stated herein; otherwise this ordinance is amendatory and supplementary to existing provision of the Paramus Code.

Section 5. Codification. This ordinance shall be codified as amendments to the chapters set forth herein.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and publication of notice of adoption as provided by law.
