Paramus Recreation is offering an affordable enrichment program for Paramus Children K-6 with Diff-Abilities. What does diff-abilities mean? Diff-Abilities is a term used by some organizations, including the Special Olympics, in an effort to remove the negative connotation of 'dis'abilities and focus on the student's skills and abilities.

Classes will feature the following:

- Creative Arts Segment: Including Music or Art Therapy
- Wellness Segment: Including a variety of activities depending on the session (ex: Copiera, yoga, dance, hockey, baseball, and/or soccer).
- Pet Therapy with certified therapy dogs and their handlers
- Preparedness & Safety: hands on practical experience with some of our Borough's emergency services.
