<p>DID YOU KNOW: After the American Revolutionary War, Paramus emerged as a farming community. Sprout Brook divided the land; barely visible today, the brook runs into Saddle River almost parallel to what is now Route 17. West of the brook was known as the lowlands, distinct with rich black soil which was perfect for growing celery. Land to the east of the brook was called the uplands.
