- *toys
- *used paper plates
- *eating utensils

Nice List

- *paper cards and envelopes
- *shopping catalogs
- *clean, dry cardboard
- *gift bags
- *glass bottles
- *non-foil wrapping paper
- *electronics—call to schedule
- *Styrofoam—must be brought to the recycle center (no packing peanuts or food containers. Must be clean/dry and free of tape or cardboard)
